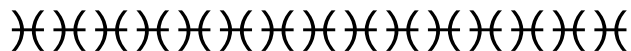

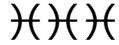

Dr. Gergana Panova-Tekath is a Professor of Dance at Folkwang University (Essen) and Chair of the Ethnochoreology Department at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (Sofia). She organizes frequent summer culture seminars in Bulgaria; and has taught dance workshops in Europe, Asia, and North and South America. She teaches dances from all ethnographic regions of Bulgaria with a special emphasis on their traditional, ritual, and contemporary aspects.

Gergana is trained as a stage performer, dance teacher, choreographer, ethnologist, stage director, and Laban notator and is an author. In her two-volume book ("Tanz nach der Wende," 2011), the first volume focuses on the human body in a social/cultural context, both in terms of child-to-adult development and in the specific context of Bulgaria vis-à-vis Western Europe. The second volume provides more historic/political context; identifies both "firm and fluid" forms of authenticity; and describes how body movement and forms of speech are apparent in the old and new habits of a changing Europe.

A little more about Gergana Panova-Tekath:

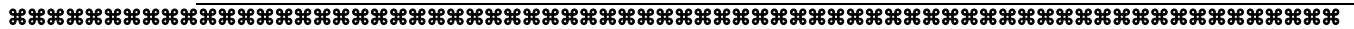
Gergana co-founded the Theater Department of the New Bulgarian University (Sofia); was director of the National Dance Archive at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences; and has served as visiting professor in Berlin, Zurich, TU Dortmund, and Vienna. She is also a good friend and colleague of Yves Moreau. Yves reports. "She is great teacher with a warm and exuberant personality, with a vast knowledge of Bulgarian folklore - including very contemporary folklore."
